Advisory Board	Organisations and groups representative of the sector.	Unite the activity of the SSAS partners to maximise their effective impact on the future of P.E., school sport and physical activity, by defining ways of working in a Terms of Reference.
Convener	Youth Sport Trust.	Own the meeting schedule.  Manage membership to the partnership.  Provide governance of the partnerships actions.  Own the Terms of Reference and its review.
